On Jocelyn Benoist's Realist Philosophy

In *Concepts. Introduction à l'analyse* (Paris, 2010) and in *Éléments de philosophie réaliste* (Paris, 2011) Jocelyn Benoist reassesses the relation between concepts and reality developing a new realist philosophy. What are concepts? How do they work? Are they the reality itself? What is the relation between concepts and the context? What is the distinction between conceptual and not-conceptual realm? What is the role of the intentionality? What is social reality? The present issue of *Philosophical Readings* aims to explore Benoist's new approach to philosophy considering any aspect of his philosophy of mind, of language and of ontology.

Submissions should be made to the Editors (editors@philosophicalreadings.com). An abstract of not more than seventy words should accompany the submission. Since *Philosophical Readings* has adopted a policy of blind review, information identifying the author should only appear on a separate page.

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
